Travis Sydes provided update on the process for review of 2015 Regional Mountain Bike Strategy being conducted by FNQROC.

The information being obtained for the Tablelands Region Cycling Strategy will assist and inform FNQROC.

Travis outlined the unique experience that the Tablelands region can offer which has been captured by members previously including adaptive cycling, women in cycling, visitor experiences – Rainforest to Savannah and more.

Aim is to identify each region in FNQ uniqueness, resource capability across local government, regional trail maintenance etc.
