Chief Executive Officer	The power to administer or feed an animal a substance that Council knows is harmful or poisonous to the animal, with the intention of injury or killing the animal	Sections 36(1) <i>Animal Care and Protection Act 2001</i>	6 November 2014	A local government is a prescribed entity for the purpose of the ACPA, See also, section 10 of the Animal Care and Protection Regulation 2012.
Chief Executive Officer	In the specified circumstances, the power to agree in writing to the transfer of ownership of animal or other thing.	Section 156 <i>Animal Care and Protection Act 2001</i>	6 November 2014	
Chief Executive Officer	In the specified circumstances, the power to deal with an animal or other thing that has become the property of Council as considered appropriate.	Section 157 (2) <i>Animal Care and Protection Act 2001</i>	6 November 2014	
Chief Executive Officer	In the specified circumstances, the power to recover costs from an animal's owner or former owner for costs necessarily and reasonably incurred in relation to the interests of the animal's welfare or its destruction.	Section 189(2) <i>Animal Care and Protection Act 2001</i>	6 November 2014	
Chief Executive Officer	In the specified circumstances, the power to agree in writing to the transfer of ownership of animal.	Section 214A(2) <i>Animal Management (Cats and Dogs) Act 2008</i>	6 November 2014
