Chief Executive	Power to, with the approval of the Minister and the district disaster coordinator for the disaster district in which the local government is situated, to agree to unite with other local governments, for the purpose of establishing a local group. Chief Executive	Power to give written notice of the members of a local group to: (a) the chief executive; and (b) the chairperson for the disaster district in which the local group is situated.	Section 37 <i>Disaster Management Act 2023</i>	28 May 2020	
Chief Executive	Power to consider other matters that are appropriate for inclusion in the local disaster management plan.	Section 57(2)(g) <i>Disaster Management Act 2023</i>	28 May 2020	
Chief Executive	Power, subject to subsection 2, to review or renew a local disaster management plan when considered appropriate.	Section 59(1) <i>Disaster Management Act 2023</i>	28 May 2020	
Chief Executive	Power to consider the places where a copy of the local disaster management plan should be available for inspection, free of charge, by members of the public.	Section 60(1)(c) <i>Disaster Management Act 2023</i>	28 May 2020
